Hydrogen heavy-duty projects joining forces

Interreg North-West Europe projects H2-Share and HECTOR recently joined forces with the FCH-JU project REVIVE. Last week the mobile hydrogen refuelling station of H2-Share (the 'WyRefueler') refuelled two zero-emission garbage trucks simultaneously in Breda. It is a first that three different heavy-duty, hydrogen projects join forces and reinforce each other.

Colruyt Group tests 27 tonne 'H2-Share' hydrogen truck in Belgium and France

In the past few months, Colruyt Group has been testing the H2-Share 27-tonne 'range extender' electric truck with hydrogen in Belgium, after having tested a 44-tonne hydrogen truck earlier this year. The group will now also test this 27-tonne truck for a month in France.
