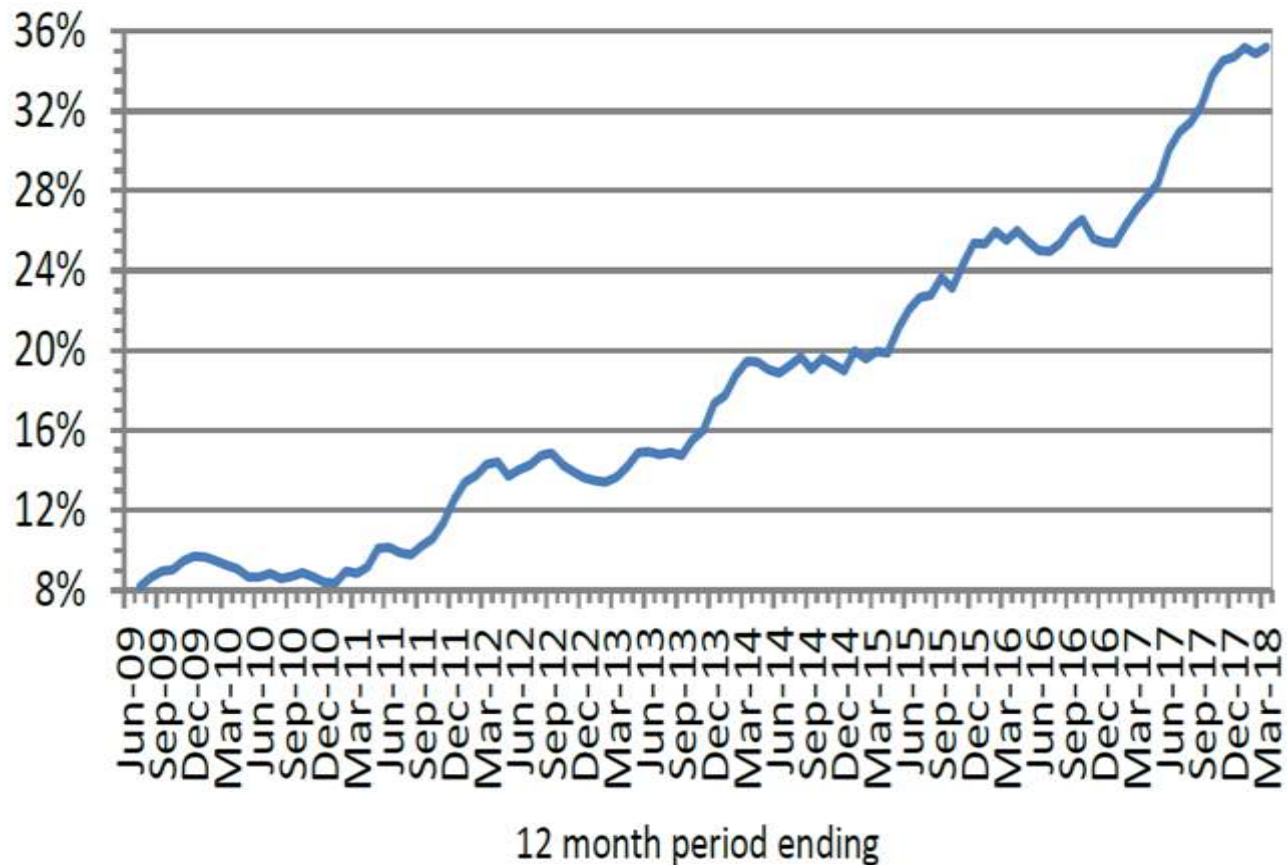

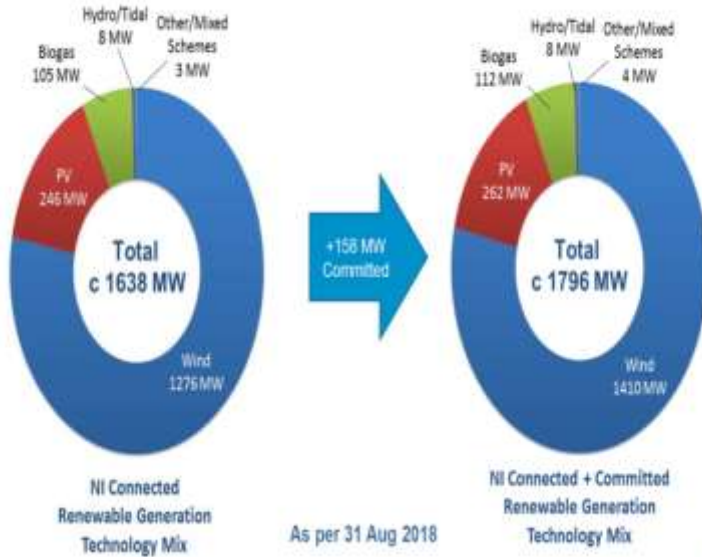
Renewable Generation in Northern Ireland

Rolling 12 month Average % of Total Electricity Consumption Generated from Indigenous Renewable Sources

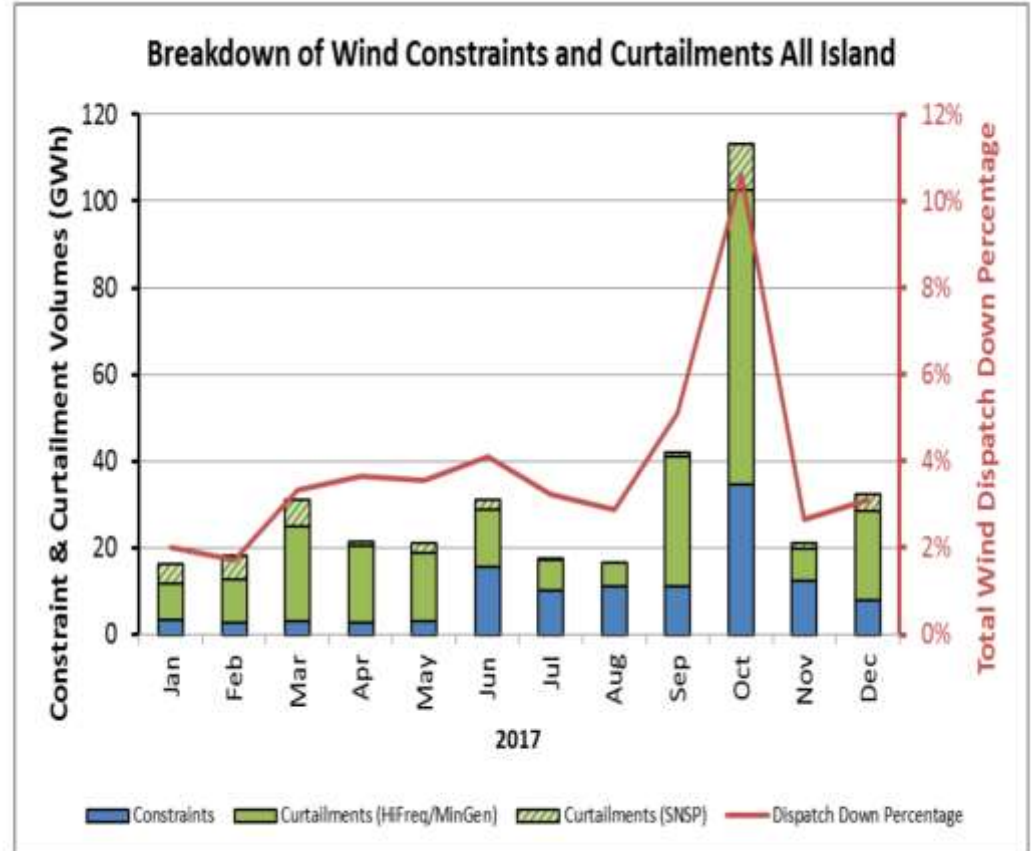


Wind Curtailment - Ireland
