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MC 1 - 14 & 15 September 2022 – Saarbrücken (Germany)

Item 1 – Official opening

Welcome speech by Mrs Elena Yorgova-Ramanauskas (Saarland State Secretary for Economics, Innovation, Digital Affairs & Energy) and Mrs Vera Moosmayer (Head of the Directorate for Spatial Planning and Regional Policy at the Federal Ministry for Housing, Urban Development and Building, Germany).

Item 7 - Capitalisation strategy

Decisions:

- MC took note of the main capitalisation activities for 2025.
- MC approved the indicative timeline for two calls for capitalisation.
- MC confirmed the amount of 10 MEUR ERDF for a capitalisation call and took note of the available alternative sources to eventually add to that amount.
- MC took note and prepared for an informal Member States Reflection meeting by the end of June 2025 which will address modalities of capitalisation calls, in particular, the targets for a capitalisation call and selection criteria.







Item 8 – Project implementation (calls 1 to 3)

Decisions:

- MC took note of the project modifications overview.
- MC took note of the update on project CIRCULAR RENO.

<u>Item 9 – Call 4 – step 2 update</u> Decisions:

- MC decided that the "Re-Heat-Appartment" project application did not meet its technical requirements by the set deadline in a substantial manner.
- With this, the MC also decided not to proceed with the signature of the subsidy contract and hence not to fund the "Re-Heat-Appartment" application.

<u> Item 10 – Call 5 step 1</u>
